Law School Certificate	A form that must be signed and submitted to each law school attended by an applicant. The form indicates if an applicant has met the educational requirement of graduation from an American Bar Association accredited law school.	
Multistate Bar Exam (MBE)	The 200 question multiple choice portion of the examination given on the last Wednesday of February and July. This test is given in two three-hour AM and PM sessions.	
MBE State	The state in which an applicant will sit for the MBE. Pennsylvania requires applicants to take the MBE in Pennsylvania.	
MBE Score Transfer	If an applicant is taking the MBE in more than one state, the applicant <b>must</b> arrange for the transfer of the MBE score, either to or from New Jersey. Please note that Pennsylvania requires their applicants to sit for the MBE in Pennsylvania. New Jersey does not handle MBE transfers to another state; applicants must contact the National Conference of Bar Examiners to transfer an MBE score from New Jersey to another state.
